Woodturning Scholarships

The AAW Endowment Trust Fund (ETF) and the Arrowmont School of Arts and Crafts will make available funds for 14 \$550 scholarships at Arrowmont School of Arts and Crafts. In addition, the ETF, working with John C. Campbell Folk School will award 13 \$594 scholarships. Altogether, 27 scholarships will be awarded. In total, \$15,422 in scholarships will be given to AAW members. In order to apply for the scholarships, nominees must be an AAW members and be nominated by their AAW Chapter. If you are interested, let me know so you can be considered.

October Meeting Notes

Demo: Spiraling on Hollow Forms, Goblet Stems, and Finials.

Demonstrator: Stuart Mortimer

Stuart Mortimer lives in Hampshire, England and is a self-taught turner since 1968. He has won many international awards for his turnings and his instruction. He travels worldwide attending seminars and exhibitions as a sought after teacher and demonstrator. His work is hand crafted on and off a lathe using hand held electrical powered tools as well as traditional carving tools. He started spiral work in the early 1980's to decorate a wide range of work from twisted miniature goblets, candle sticks, bowls, hollow forms, artistic and other decorative works.



Stuart retired from the London Police Force in 1989 and has since built up a strong International following for his individual works including spiral work, some say to new levels. Major works are often topped off and easily identified by a twisted finial that has become a distinctive feature or trademark. He is the holder of the World Record for the largest bowl turned in 1997 in the USA authenticated and certified by the Guinness book of records.

He uses other decorating techniques including burning, carving (sculptural work), ebonising, and piercing.

Stuart will demonstrate the techniques he uses in the art of spiraling on hollow forms, goblet stems, finials, etc. This is one demo you do not want to miss. Also he will do a full day demonstration on Monday October 7, 2013. Details next.

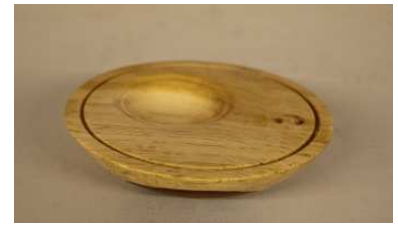
