OCTOBER MEETING

Demonstrator: Stephen Ogle

For the October 11 meeting of CWT, Stephen Ogle demonstrated his system for tool sharpening. I'm sure that most of us have some sharpening system that we use in our shop to keep our tools sharp. Remember that sharp tools are safer tools. Stephen had something that was a little different than most. For one thing, his system was shop made and therefore more affordable, and seems to be fairly simple to achieve repeatable results on various types tools.

One of the features I thought to be interesting was that the grind was flat rather than concave as with most other sharpening systems based on wheel grinders.
