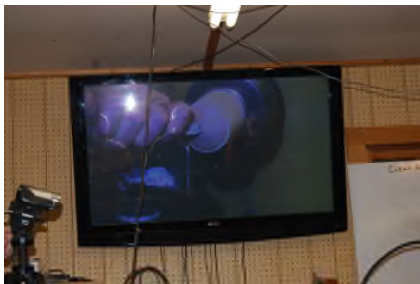

In the last several years, I have become known among wood turners for turning micro miniature goblets. These are 1-3 inches tall, with toothpick size stems, turned off-center, with captured rings. Recently, I have included other miniature forms and have participated in national shows for miniature enthusiasts.

He expertly demonstrated all of the texturing and chattering tools and gave us some of the finer points on how to vary the patterns. 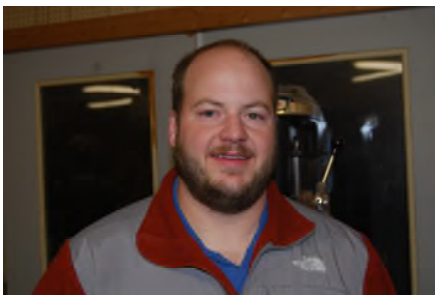

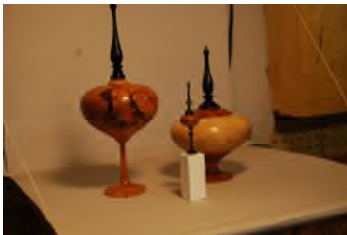
