Keith’s demo went over how he approaches a turned and carved sculpture piece and included wood selection, planning and tool techniques and the use of eccentric jigs. He also demonstrated the use of some of his personal jigs he has created to make his off center/ eccentric turnings. Keith gave us some unique and interesting approaches to turning, but it will take some practice and hard work to master these techniques.

Bring a lunch, drinks available for \$1.00


DEMONSTRATOR: Rudy Lopez

BIOGRAPHY: Although Rudolph Lopez is a relatively new artist in woodturning, he began working with his hands at a very young age. With an education in drafting and design, he began his relationship with wood as a craftsman of fine furniture and cabinetry. He has spent many years building furniture and works as a professional advertising photographer. The transition into woodturning has been a seamless flow into another creative endeavor.

"I have always had a love of nature and with that came my love of wood. I love everything about wood, rough or smooth it possesses a warm welcome feel. Wood grows from the earth, with its endless earthy color variations, the swirling grain patterns of burls and knotty woods. It has an unlimited potential for creativity but also flaws and faults, cracks, knots and other defects which sometimes makes it difficult to work with.....this is my favorite kind of wood."

Rudolph's work has been included in several American Association of Woodturners juried exhibitions. He received the Emerging Artist Award at the Raymond James Gasparilla Festival of the Arts in 2009, and chosen as one of the four international emerging artists of 2012 by the AAW. His work is currently displayed at the St. Petersburg Museum of Fine Arts Museum store, St Petersburg, Fl. To view more of Rudolph's work please visit his web-site www.rudolphlopez.com

DEMONSTRATION: I will be turning a thin natural edge wing bowl from a green log or crotch section. Design and layout considerations regarding limb orientation, crotch figure, keeping or eliminating features or flaws in the wood will be covered. I will explain and demonstrate the technique I use for turning thin on interrupted cuts allowing the wood to warp and move which influences the final piece and helps avoid cracking. Explanations on using and sharpening Negative Rake scrapers, sanding wet wood both on and off of the lathe along with different finishing techniques

The workshop format will be the facilitator demonstrating the project to be turned and then students will have hands-on work time with individual coaching. In this workshop, participants will be guided on doing two projects: A goblet and a multiple center disc.

He conducts regular classes in his own studio, near Asheville, NC. Joe is a member of the Southern Highland Craft Guild, past president and Board Member of Carolina Mountain Woodturners and member of American Association of Woodturners
