MARCH MEETING

DEMONSTRATOR: Mike Peace

DEMONSTRATION: The March 14, 2017, meeting was highlighted by the demonstration of CWT member, Mike Peace. Mike is a very prolific Youtube contributor and is very skilled in demonstrating various techniques in wood turning. This demo was all about the skew.

Mike began the demo by giving an example of how a skew can perform cuts in a variety of ways—peeling, planing, vee, bead, facing and specialty cuts. He encouraged those of us who were not completely comfortable with the skew, to practice, practice, practice on 2X4 stock.

Several types of skews were discussed, and Mike demonstrated some of the characteristics of rectangular, oval, and round skews. He then covered the sharpening process as well. Mike provided a well-planned informative demonstration to a well-attended meeting. Mike concluded the demo by answering questions from the members.

Surface embellishments for your turnings

Mark will demonstrate all the various techniques and methods he uses to embellish his work. He will show how he lays out geometric patterns on turned vessels, using the lathe as a clamp. Techniques covered include carving with power and hand tools, engraving and even some textures done on the lathe. He will be using a home-made woodburner and demonstrate how he uses milk paints and dyes to enhance the carved patterns.

Students will get a chance to experiment with all the tools and techniques.

Workshop Date: **June 13, 2017** 10:30AM to 5:30PM

Cost: \$60 for CWT members. Non-chapter members \$70. Lathes, chucks, tools and face shields are provided but you are welcome to bring your own.

There are 8 slots for students so reserve yours early. Preference will be for CWT members, but after May 10, 2017 the slots will be made available to other chapters.

Items to Bring: Bring a sack lunch. Cold drinks are available for a \$1. Students should bring pieces to work on, they may be seconds, failures, defects and even just some pieces of wood to mess around on. Also, bring wood that can be used as a jam chuck to hold your pieces between centers, Face shields and basic turning tools are provided, but you are welcome to bring your own. Bring any carving or texturing tools that you might already have.
